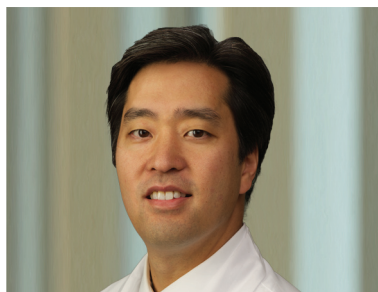


Frederick B. Lee, M.D.
