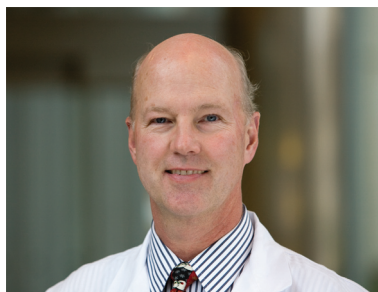


William J. Wilson, M.D.
